USDA CPHST is pleased to announce the release of Citrus Diseases, developed through collaboration among CPHST's Identification Technology Program (ITP), University of Florida, and USDA-APHIS-PPQ. Citrus Diseases was designed to provide screening support for individuals responsible for inspecting citrus imports and federal, state and local personnel responsible for survey and detection of citrus diseases. The tool provides support for symptom-based identification of citrus diseases that are already known in the United States, as well as those of immediate concern. Twenty-four diseases and commonly confused disorders are included in the digital identification tool.
